

Chandigarh to Spiti Bike Tour

Day 01 Arrival in Chandigarh



Reach your pre-booked hotel in Chandigarh, check-in and relax for a while. You will then meet your road-captain for a briefing session and day-wise plan. After that, you will be introduced to the Royal Enfield bikes that you will ride throughout the tour. Later, have dinner, go to your bed and prepare for the next day.

You will be provided with a bike (Royal Enfield Himalayan) for 9 days starting from Chandigarh upto there.

Day 02 Chandigarh - Narkanda

Breakfast Dinner

Check out from your hotel and set out on a scenic road trip towards Narkanda, also known as the apple capital of the country. As you proceed further, the terrain gets more rugged, offering sweeping views of the Himalayan ranges. The twists and turns of the road take you into the pine-scented air, and occasional glimpses of terraced



Start early to beat the traffic out of Chandigarh and head towards the Himalayas on the Himalayan Expressway. On the way, you will be passing through Chail, a hill station in the lower Himalayan range and home to beautiful flower orchards. After a short lunch break, you will head towards Narkanda, known as the fruit bowl of Himachal Pradesh. Apple and cherry trees line the roadsides and the tall Deodar fir trees spread their sweet aroma all around.

Day 03 Narkanda - Chitkul



The last inhabited village on the Indo-Tibet border

After check-out, start your journey from the hotel towards Chitkul, which is the last inhabited village before the Indo-China border. Embark on a beautiful road trip while enjoying the immense beauty of Kinnaur Valley. Turn right from Karcham along the Sutlej River and reach Chitkul. You can also visit 'Hindustan ka Aakhri Dhaba', famous for delicious food. Later, check-in and relax at the hotel/homestay for overnight stay.



Embark on a scenic bike ride to behold Kinnaur Valley's exquisite vistas. Trace the Sutlej river's path until Karcham; then, turn right to Chitkul, tracing the Baspa river. Chitkul, the final village before Indo-China border, showcases stunning Himalayan scenery. Don't miss the renowned 'Hindustan ka Akhri Dhaba' for a fulfilling meal amid this beauty.

Day 04 Chitkul - Kalpa



Check out from the hotel and resume your bike journey towards the quaint town of Kalpa situated on the banks of river Sutlej. Head back towards Karcham and turn left from Powari to reach Reokang Peo, the main town of Kinnaur district. After reaching Kalpa, spend a comfortable night in a camp/homestay from where you can admire the beauty of Kinnaur Kailash peak.



Day 05 Kalpa - Kaza



Check out from your camp and start the journey by road towards Kaza, the beautiful town of Spiti Valley. Cross the Khab Bridge and the confluence of Spiti and Sutlej rivers on the way. Stop at Nako Lake for lunch. Proceed past Sumdo, turn right to see Gue Monastery. Proceed towards Tabo Monastery, the 'Ajanta of the Himalayas' and reach Kaza. Later, check in to your hotel/homestay for overnight stay.

Day 06 Kaza Explore



Wake up and get ready to start sightseeing around Kaza. Start with a visit to the magnificent Key Monastery adorned with historic frescoes and weapons. Visit Langza village and visit the Long Temple. Then, head to Hikkim, which has the world's highest post office. Visit Komik, Asia's highest village. Return to your Kaza hotel/homestay for overnight stay.

Day 07 Kaza - Chandratal



Check out from your hotel/homestay in Kaza and begin your journey to Chandratal Lake. Experience a beautiful journey amidst the Himalayas. Beyond Kunzum La pass, turn right 4 km before Batal. Reach Chandratal Lake and camp overnight near this crescent-shaped gem, soaking in its infinite beauty.



Day 08 Chandra Taal - Rohtang La - Manali



Check-out from your camp and start moving towards Manali. Pass through the iconic Rohtang Pass and feast your eyes on the spectacular view of the Himalayan ranges. On reaching Manali, settle down at your hotel to relax for a while. Walk around the charming Mall Road or find peace at the iconic Hadimba Devi Temple. Spend a comfortable night at your hotel.



Day 09 Manali - Chandigarh



Pack your bags and check-out from the hotel. Start your bike journey back to Chandigarh. On reaching Chandigarh, hand over your bike and bid farewell to your fellow riders. Return home with a bag full of memories.
